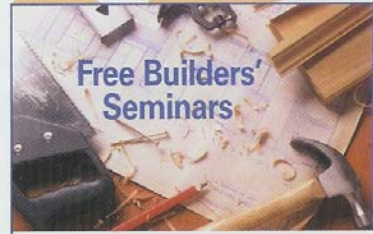
Congratulations, scholarship winners!
